### **NSE MARKET HALT ON MARCH 13, 2020**

The NSE wishes to notify market participants, investors, key stakeholders and the general public that trading at the NSE was halted on Friday 13, March 2020 at 2:38 p.m. as per the provisions of Rule 9.4.1 (ii) of the NSE Equity Trading Rules which provides that *when the NSE 20 Share Index decreases by more than 5% at the opening session compared to its closing value or during the continuous session, compared to its opening value, the Exchange may temporarily halt trading for not more than 30 minutes.*

Normal market activity will resume on Monday 16, March 2020.
